# RRS 26 Starting Recalls

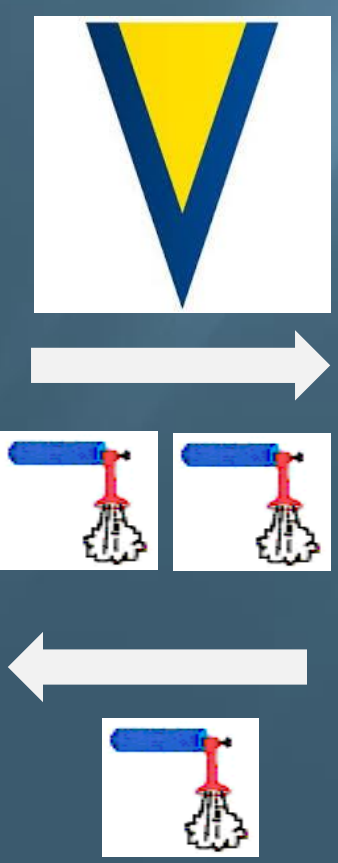
- **X Flag- Individual Recall**

Some identifiable boats are over and must return to start properly



- **1st Substitute- General Recall**

Too many boats are over to identify all that violated the starting procedure





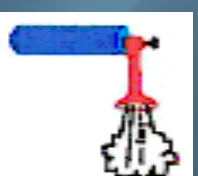
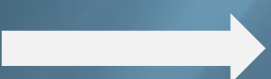
# Sighting a Line

- You may be asked to contribute to calling boats over early by **SATL NUMBERS**
- Follow procedure outlined by **PRO**
- **PRO** has ultimate say and may overrule

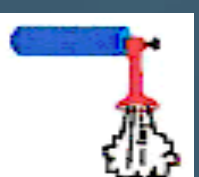
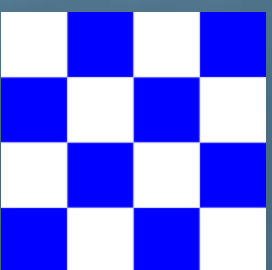
# RRS 26 Starting Procedures

- Before **WARNING** – Courses are posted
- Up to **PREPATORY** – A Starting Mark can be moved
- Anytime up Start signal

**Postpone**



**Abandon**



# After Class Start

- Confirm number of boats starting.
- Competitors must START with in 4 minutes or are scored DNS.
- If Individual Recall confirm OCS starters return and start properly. Remove X-RAY with no sound, when all have returned and started properly of after 4 minutes which ever occurs first.
- Prepare for next class sequence in 1 minute.

# After All Classes Start

- Re-confirm number of boats in each class.
- Mark Boat to Remove Yellow Starting Pin.
- Display orange finish line flag.
- Remove Courses from Course Board
- Prepare finish sheet clipboards.
- Actions permitted by the RRS
  - Shortening or Abandoning the Course (RRS 32)
  - Changing the Course (RRS 33)
  - Mark Missing (RRS 34)
  - Outside Help (RRS 41)

# Finishing

- ▣ A boat *finishes* when any part of her hull, or crew or equipment in normal position, crosses the finishing line from the course side. However, she has not *finished* if after crossing the finishing line she:
  1. takes a penalty under rule 44.2,
  2. corrects an error under rule 28.2 made at the line, or;
  3. continues to sail the course.

# RRS 32

## 32 SHORTENING OR ABANDONING AFTER THE START

**32.1** After the starting signal, the race committee may shorten the course (display flag S with two sounds) or *abandon* the race (display flag N, N over H, or N over A, with three sounds), as appropriate,

- (a) because of an error in the starting procedure,
- (b) because of foul weather,
- (c) because of insufficient wind making it unlikely that any boat will *finish* within the time limit,
- (d) because a *mark* is missing or out of position, or
- (e) for any other reason directly affecting the safety or fairness of the competition,

or may shorten the course so that other scheduled races can be sailed. However, after one boat has sailed the course and *finished* within the time limit, if any, the race committee shall not *abandon* the race without considering the consequences for all boats in the race or series.

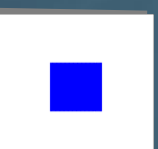

# Recoding a Finish

- At the approach, the Line Sighter announces "Stand-by" for "Sail Number".
- The moment of finish is announced with "MARK" and a sound signal .
- Spotter confirms the SAIL NUMBER and records the order of finish by sail number only.
- At "stand-by" Timer announces the Hour, Minutes & Seconds.
- At "Mark" the Recorder records the Hour, Minutes & Seconds.

## Remember

**multiple Starts but only ONE Finish  
So get it right !!!**

# Emergency Procedures

- Every event should have an emergency procedure in place
- Know where to take someone in case of an emergency
- Know who in the RC team has medical training
- Make sure everyone is on the same page
